

Finding the Artist Within is a special needs program for those with physical disabilities, cognitive, developmental, and mental health disorders. The creative process in making an art piece offers persons with physical or cognitive challenges the opportunity to further develop skills. interests and competencies across their lives. WHAM offers ongoing studio-based classes staffed by practicing artists who provide support and assistance to the students.



Our WHAM classroom has a wheelchair accessible entrance, located in a quiet area at the art center

To all of you artists who work with glass, I am asking if you would be interested in a secure, studio space to work in. This space includes several small grinders, a small glass kiln, cutters, a large work table, padded flooring and a storage space that can be locked.

This studio space will be available in the fall. The intention is to rent this studio to several people to share with special access just for making glass art. The rental fee will be \$150 per month and you will have access to all of the equipment plus locking storage space for your glass and tools.
