

A special thanks to Debra Goley for all her work with the Newsletter and as a Member of WHAM. Here's what she'd been up to. Debra Goley branches out and we couldn't be more proud.

WHAM member and former team member, Debra Goley's work has been accepted into Visions Gallery Art Quilts XXVIII in Chandler AZ. Opens Saturday November 18 at 4-6pm with artist reception. Work juried by Shelly White to be included in Art Quilts: Breaking Rules,

Honoring Tradition at Vision Gallery from November 18, 2023 – January 12, 2024. Debra Goley's work for this exhibition: "Sit It Out or Swing" as first seen juried into abstract division in Houston International Quilt Festival Nov 2022 and WHAM gallery juried into Arizona Art Alliance Interpretations VIII in March, 2023 whereby she won third place.

Debra's work will also be featured in juried exhibition at the Phoenix Sky Harbor Airport . Her artwork, Dad, Me and Live TV, has been selected for Phoenix Airport Museum's Night Vision exhibition at Sky Harbor International Airport. The venue

received 536 entries by 211 artists from around the state and 66 artworks were selected.

On display in Terminal 4, Level 3 from October 21, 2023, to May 26, 2024. Debra's art hung in the Wham gift shop and is for sale and is once it leaves the Airport commitment loan. The work was created and debuted for three-year National tour in honor of the 50 th anniversary of Man's Walk on The Moon.

Currently her work, "Island of Steel" as seen below right center and "In and Out" are at the Shemer gallery.


