

Connie Whitlock Gets A Legend Award Come In And See What She's Building





September 16, 2025 the Surprise Interfaith & Golden Rule Community held their third Annual Community Legend Awards at the Dysart Schools District Office. This year Connie Whitlock was honored at the 2025 recipient of the Individual Legend.

Connie is the Founder and Executive Director of the WHAM Art Association, which has been providing art programs to the West Valley for 19 years. WHAM resides in an 8500 square ft. building housing a professional Art Gallery, 16 working artists' studios, classrooms, a full clay studio, and glass room to facilitate art education taught from the experienced instructors. WHAM, with is large membership of three hundred plus, gives back to the community in many ways bringing art to the parks in their WHAM on Wheels event trailer, providing outside art classes in Literary Arts to Visual Arts in 7 West Valey Cites. WHAM has a robust outreach department giving art to Veteran's, Teens, Special Needs, Dementia Patients, and recovered Sexually Trafficked Girls. WHAM has provided many clay and painted murals across the Valley as well as works with schools. WHAM believes ART is for ALL and is inclusive not exclusive.


