Our reasonable prices are for room rental are: Half Day (4 hours) Non-Member \$60/Member \$50 Full Day (8 hour) Non-Member \$110/Member \$90

Tuesday, Wednesday or Thursday you can rent the room for 2hrs for: Non-Member \$35

Member \$25

The benefits of Renting WHAM's classroom to teach art classes are: Space that has tables and chairs for your students. We have a small kitchen/lunchroom area to be used if needed.

WHAM is charging a 5% processing fee per student along with your room rental. WHAM will advertise your class on social media and email your class information to hundreds of artists on our mailing list.

- ART EXCHANGE: Items must be clean and wired for hanging. Each artist member is allowed to bring in 3 pieces in the 3-D room and 3 pieces of wall art. 5 Prints are allowed to be displayed in the hallway for a 6 month period.
